Dear parents and carers,

I hope you had a relaxing Christmas and I hope 2018 is a year to be celebrated. The children have come back ready to learn and we have welcomed a new set of children into Nursery – welcome to the Churchfields family. As we start the new year, a reminder of some key information:

PE

A reminder that your child should have their PE kit in school. The days that your child has PE is the same as it was last term and is on the school website for those who need a reminder. Year 4 will begin their swimming sessions next week. Can I remind parents that children should be able to remove earrings for PE lessons or bring plasters to cover them. On occasions, Mr Salt and Mr Routledge may take the children outside for PE, therefore I would suggest a pair of tracksuit bottoms may be a good item for these cold months.

Before and After school clubs and provision

During the spring term, there will be no after school clubs other than the Stoke City football club on a Monday with a cost of £3 a session. This is to enable staff to offer boosters to year 6 and year 2.

A reminder that the school runs a breakfast club at a cost of £2.50 a session or £10 a week. We also now offer an after school provision 3:00 – 5:00 at a cost of £4 a session. If you wish to book in for these, please go to the main office and speak to Mrs Tucker or Mrs Darlington.

Attendance and Mornings

A reminder that the school opens its doors at 8:30 with registration beginning at 8:40. Can I ask that if you wish to speak to the class teacher, you come to the main office between 8:20– 8:30 or phone to make an appointment. This will mean the teacher will have time to chat and listen to your concerns. Can I also remind you that if your child is off school for any reason, can you call the main office to let us know between 7:30 – 8:30.

Mobile phones

As Year 6 are preparing for their move to high school, I am aware that many received mobile phones for Christmas. Can I please ask that if any child does bring their phone into school that they hand it into the office in order for it to be secure.
