Dear Parents and Carers,

Wowee! Year 6 have only just come back and here we are letting you know about things going on in 2024!

Firstly, we are writing to you to ask you if you would be interested in buying a 'Leavers Hoodie' for your child. Owing to the way the company manufactures them, we will have to ask you for £20 when you order them, which is the full cost of the 'Leavers Hoodie.' This will need to be put onto ParentPay before an order can be made. You can order them at any point from now until the final payment date of Friday 15th March 2024. We will be unable to make any changes to orders after this date including adding any extra hoodies. As you can see, this year we are ordering the hoodies much, much earlier than previously. This will give the children the opportunity to wear them in school during their final term at Churchfields. They won't get them earlier, it just helps with paying. Please note that (like previous years) the Leavers Hoodies are always given out on the Friday of SATs week which will be on Friday 17th May 2024. Like previous years, we will organise a reward activity for the completion of SATs tests which we will inform you about nearer the time.

Following on from the immense success this year, will also be organising a Leavers Fest which was incredibly popular with the majority of last year's Y6. The cost is £25, it includes absolutely EVERYTHING that the children eat, drink, or experience on the night. It will be the Friday before we break up for the summer and this is **Friday 12th July 2024** from **6.30pm**.

And last, but by no means least, in the summer term we always go to Alton Towers as a reward for the children's entire time at Churchfields as part of the Churchfields family. As this is a "REWARD TRIP" that is fully funded from the school budget (**not** from any school fundraising) children are expected to have an EXCELLENT behaviour record to be allowed to go on the reward trip. Shortly, you will receive a letter informing you, exactly what is meant by this. We know, from previous years, that the children in year 6 will have **exemplary behaviour** in class and around school, throughout the year.

A quick reminder that children in year 6 need to be in school as much as possible from September, all the way up until SATs testing week beginning **Monday 13th May 2024**. We **do not recommend** any holidays during this period and children MUST be in school during statutory SATs testing week.
