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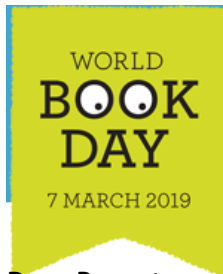

Dear Parents and Carers,

Just before we break up for half term week, here are some reminders. On the week beginning 4<sup>th</sup> March, we have World Book Week. Our week celebrating reading begins with: [Creative Characters on Monday](#). This is where we invite the children to make a model at home of a character from a story book. There will be a winner in each class and an overall winner in EYFS, KS1, year 3/4 and year 5/6. How you choose to create your model is entirely up to you. On [Tuesday](#) and [Wednesday](#), in **school**, the children will be making their learning space 'BOOKTASTIC'; [Thursday](#) is the official World Book Day, so the children are invited to dress up as story book characters or non-fiction people (eg dress up as a firefighter); and we round off the week with Bedtime Stories.

On [Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March](#), we invite all the children to come to school in their sleepwear and bring their favourite bedtime story and bedtime toy, bear or comfort blanket to share with the class. We are going to have hot chocolate and biscuits in each class whilst they are sharing books. Older children may want to bring in more grown up books and this is naturally to be encouraged.

**The following week** (beginning 11<sup>th</sup> March) **will be Comic Relief**. Remember, we will put out buckets for 'Gunge the Grown up' and **don't forget** we're going to have Smarten up Scruffy Skuphy! In a special assembly during the afternoon of Red Nose Day, we're going to give him a magic make over and get rid of that awful beard! Also on the Friday of **Red Nose Day**, we invite the children to come in their own clothes or (for a real laugh) **someone else's clothes**. If they are wearing a red nose (of any kind), they do not need to make a voluntary contribution.

We are currently taking orders on ParentPay for official Comic Relief red noses which we will then purchase for the children and will delivered by the School Council to your child on the week of Comic Relief. They are £1.25 and one nose per child in school. If you wish to purchase any other red noses, they are on sale in Sainsbury's.
