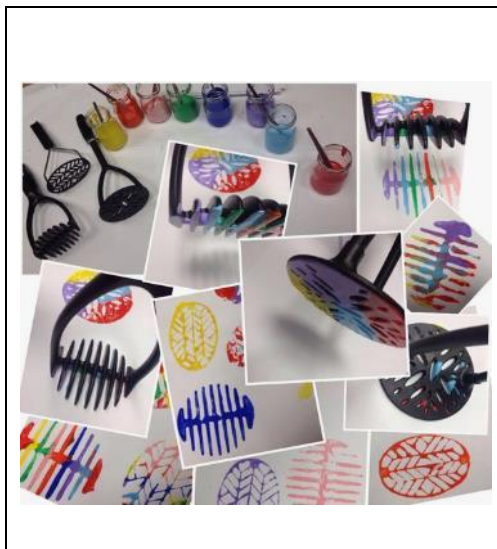

Primary Colours. 	These are colours that cannot be created by mixing other colours. They are colours in their own right. These are red, yellow and blue.
