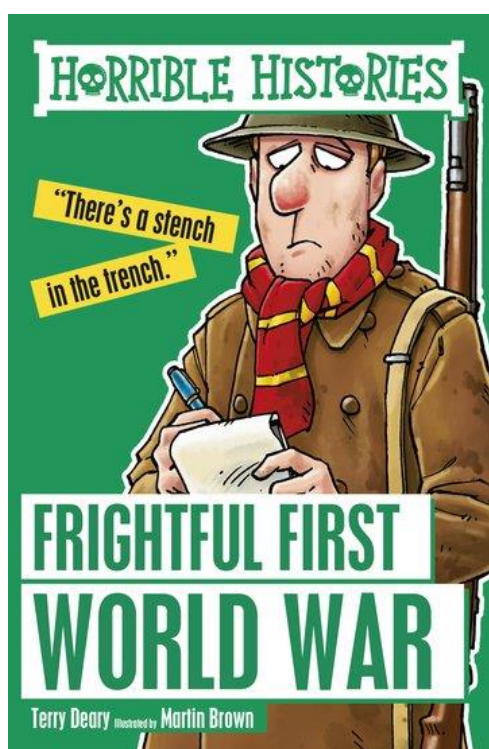


Book of the Month
