It is important that children are in their classroom by 8:30 as this is when learning starts. If your child doesn't get to the classroom until 8:45 they are missing 1 ½ hours of learning each week – that's over a week of learning lost over the year.

At the end of the school day, lots of children are leaving the site. To help with dismissal please ensure that you leave space between the dismissal point and where you stand. This is to help teachers dismiss easily as they can then see parents. If you wish to speak to the class teacher please wait until they have dismissed all of the children.
