The man who wore all his clothes</li> </ol> <p><b>WCR</b> The Smeds and the Smoos</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">On the Way Home</p>	<p><b>Capital letters</b> also called upper case usually taller in size used at the start of a sentence and a proper noun</p> <p><b>finger spaces</b> gaps left between words</p> <p><b>full stops</b> a dot to show the end of a statement or command sentence</p> <p><b>noun</b> person, place or thing</p> <p><b>verb</b> doing, having or being</p> <p><b>adjective</b> describes a noun</p> <p><b>conjunction</b> a word to connect phrases and sentences (and, but)</p> <p><b>statements</b> tells you something</p> <p><b>tense</b> shows if writing is set in the past, present or future</p> <p><b>Fiction</b> text written about imaginary things – not true</p> <p><b>Phonics</b> a way of teaching reading by knowing the sounds of letters</p> <p><b>Text</b> written work</p> <p><b>High frequency words</b> words that are often used</p> <p><b>Common exception words</b> words that can't be sounded out using phonics</p>

<b>Art and Design</b>	Drawing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Know that there are different ways of creating lines/marks</li> <li>• Know that pattern can be created by lines</li> <li>• Know that space can be created using line</li> <li>• Know that lines can be light/dark thick/thin</li> <li>• Know that that detail can be created using line and pattern</li> <li>• Know that applying pressure to the pencil will create different tones</li> <li>• Know that texture can be created by rubbing and copying</li> </ul>
