## Allergies

A reminder that we have an increasing number of pupils in our school who have allergies. Allergens can be to trees, nuts, celery, sulphites, wheat to name a few.

Currently in school, we have children with severe nut allergies and other children with food related allergies. For their safety we ask the following:

Children wash their hands regularly

Children do not share food

Food items for birthdays to be appropriate for all

**All nut-based products should not come on to from the school premises in snack or lunch items – this is vital.** Any food items that contain nuts must not come into school. These could include:

- Spreads, e.g., chocolate spread
- Cereal bars
- Some types of biscuit containing nuts
- Condiments, e.g., satay sauce
- Cakes containing nuts
- Some snack pots containing nuts

It is important that you check the labelling of food products before sending your child in to school with them – it is not always apparent that products contain nuts or traces of nuts.
